What is the Tri-M Music Honor Society?

Tri-M, once named the “Modern Music Masters,” is the international honor society for music students in junior and senior high schools. It is a program of the Music Educators National Conference, an association of over 60,000 music education professionals nationwide who realize the importance of recognizing and motivating musical achievement in their students.

What does Tri-M do?

Many things! Tri-M serves the school and community in various ways. Some of these include: sponsoring concerts by outside organizations in our school; providing ushers for music concerts; providing soloists to perform at school events; giving solo and ensemble performances at local community organizations; honoring people in the community for their contributions to the school music program; mentoring young musicians; and much, much more!

What does Tri-M have for me?

Our Tri-M chapter meets during the school year to plan chapter activities including social activities such as attendance as a group to musical performances outside of our school, social parties, and the like. But perhaps of greatest importance is the chance to share that which is unique of all Tri-M members—the joy of musical experience. Just think how much you have in common.

What do I do to become a member?

Because Tri-M is an honor society, membership does have a few requirements. You are required to maintain at least a GPA of 2.75 in your academic subjects and a GPA of 3.25 in your music courses. Upon filling out an application of membership, candidates for membership perform a solo, or in an ensemble on a recital, or prepares an oral or written report. They also take parts in a formal membership presentation ceremony, during which time you become a first year member of the organization.

What does it cost?

Your new member fee of \$15 covers the cost to become a member of the society your first year. An annual fee of \$10 is then required to continue membership each succeeding year. As a member, you will receive a membership card each membership year and an official society pin your first year, a certificate of membership your second year, and honor cords upon graduating.

Anything else I should know?

Definitely! Outstanding student members will be recognized with the Master Musician, Tri-M Leadership, Tri-M Outstanding Service, and Honor Ensemble Participation. These awards not only give recognition to our members here at school, but on a national level as well through various publications such as Tri-M News and MENC’s Soundpost. Think how that would look on your college application! In addition, our chapter has the opportunity to receive scholarships for our members to further their musical studies.
